Welcome

A warm welcome to new members particularly those from Eastern Bay Learning Centre. With the impending closure of their Learning Centre some have opted to come and join with us.

A reminder our monthly meetings held on the afternoon of the 3rd Monday are open to all members. Cashless Donations & Raffle Tickets

At a general meeting late last year we canvassed the idea of introducing a type of loyalty donation card whereby members can pay \$20 up front in cash or online for a card with 10 spaces. Like a gym card or loyalty coffee shop you pay in advance and at each attendance you get a space on your card clipped or signed off.

Your committee has explored this idea further and a card has been designed that can fit in your wallet or behind your name tag so that each time you come to a general or special interest group meeting (Camera, Apple group) your \$2 contribution is clipped off in a cashless way.

We really appreciate your \$2 contribution to help pay for a speaker or to go towards the general running costs of our centre via a raffle. We also acknowledge in a growing cashless society that many of you don't carry cash around and this is one way you can still support our LC without cash.

This issue will be discussed further at our next Monthly meeting on Monday, May 20th and you are invited to ask questions if you choose. The use of this card will be optional.

April Monthly Meeting

Speaker: Mike Maran, Handwriting and Document Examiner and graphologist

Mike gave a very interesting talk. He is a Forensic Handwriting and Document Examiner, one of only two private examiners in NZ.

He has a Diploma in Advanced Studies in Contemporary Graphology and a certificate of completion in Questioned Handwriting and Document examination and a Certificate of



Proficiency in Signature examination issued by the International Association of Document Examiners.

Mike told us he has examined hundreds of cases of forgeries due to financial impropriety or malicious intent. He has given court evidence in NZ courts many times.

Mike's presentation was interactive. Members were asked to write their signature which was then analysed. Mike also commented on the Prime Minister's signature and that of Donald Trump! Mike concluded by saying that handwriting makes you smarter and exercises the cognitive wheels in your mind.

Altogether a very much appreciated and fun presentation.


