

Computer Upgrades

We recently had the offer of an 18-month-old iMac computer that has the latest Sonoma OS. The Management Committee decided to purchase it for \$300 to replace one of our older Mac systems that cannot be upgraded to the latest OS.

Unfortunately, our recent grant application to Blue Waters Community Trust to purchase a further three new replacement HP All-in-One PCs was unsuccessful. We do, however, acknowledge that they awarded us a generous grant last year to upgrade our photocopier.

Our remaining three HP older computers are not able to be upgraded to the Windows 11, so we have submitted a grant application to Albert-Eden Community Board to fund the replacement of these three computers. We will be notified of the outcome late October, and we will keep you informed of the outcome.

Last year we did purchase three new HP Windows 11 and two MacOS 14 (Apple) computers enabled by a generous grant from Amiga Computer Club.




New Courses for Confident Computer Users




Introduction to PC Windows Computers + Word Thursday, 17 October 1:00-3:00pm - Cost \$20.00

Reminders for Members

- 1. When named on a waiting list, enrollment in the next class is not automatic, because dates and times might not suit you. Please rebook.
- 2. We have been asked why so many courses and workshops are listed in the Brochure and Schedule of Courses that are not in the Timetables. 

For our September monthly meeting, Dr Bruce Hayward, author of the book "Volcanoes of Auckland" came to speak to our group.

Bruce gave a very interesting talk. Auckland is built over its volcanoes and suburbs named after our local volcanoes. There are 53 volcanoes in the Auckland field, Rangitoto being the youngest. Bruce showed us a map of the volcanic field in his power point presentation. He also explained the three styles of eruptions.



It was interesting to note that there are seismometers monitoring for any magma movement beneath Auckland. It is not known when the next eruption will take place and where. The presentation finished with some questions and answers.

All in all, it was a very stimulating talk and gave us much to ponder over.
