# What We Accomplished In 2024

Looking back on last year, we are pleased with the accomplishments that we achieved. These included:

- Our dedicated tutors delivered more learner hours than the previous year (1,604 hrs vs 1,548hrs) which of course means we went a long way to meet the needs of our members.
- Generous donations received from SeniorNet Eastern Bays (\$3,000) and the Albert-Eden Local Board Grant (\$3,398) which enabled us to replace our old W 10 computers with three new HP All-in-One Windows 11 computer systems; and we were able to purchase a near new second-hand 2023 model iMac for a good trade-in rate.
- As an Incorporated Society, we developed and approved our new Constitution, and our re-registration as a Charity and an Incorporated Society under the new Incorporated Societies Act 2022 was accepted by the Companies Office – thanks to Ray for his efforts here.
- A Donation Card was introduced, and 24 members took this opportunity to pay ahead a \$2 donation for 10 general meetings (like a loyalty card).
- An Open Day was held early in the year and successfully attracted new members.
- We hosted a SeniorNet Regional Day for the Upper North Island SeniorNet Learning Centres.

We offer thanks and appreciation to all those who have contributed to what we achieved in 2024. We also value and appreciate our paid-up members who support us and enable us to continue with our Mission of *training people in the 50+ age group to use and enjoy the benefits of modern technology in their everyday lives.* 

## **Busy Bees**

Although our Learning Centre was officially closed for the summer recess from late December and through to the end of January, there has been a lot of activity behind the scenes from Ray McDonald acquiring and setting up of our 3 new computers; Ray and Treasurer Paul putting together our annual accounts; several tutors rewriting their manuals; and Dawn and yours truly clearing and cleaning our existing computers ready for the new year.
