For our March monthly meeting, Edward Bennett, Historian gave a detailed talk on "Ticket to the Furthest Place on Earth (Getting to NZ from 1769 to 1969)"

Edward explained how it took a big effort for our ancestors to get to NZ. 90 days to travel from UK to NZ on board a ship. Then travel through the Suez canal took the time down to 50 days.

Edward showed many slides including some of the Flying Boat which took 12 days from London to Australia and had a capacity of 45 persons but was much more expensive than going by ship.

All in all, a very interesting presentation.
